

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

- * School begins at 8:15 a.m. each day, and dismisses at 3:00. Students who are eating breakfast are encouraged to come to school no earlier than 7:40 a.m. Non-breakfast students should arrive no earlier than 8:00 a.m. Students at Hagan Elementary are supervised from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. If your child arrives at school before 8:00, they will be supervised in the gym. The playground **IS NOT** supervised after school. Please be prompt when picking your children up from school.
- * Please call the office by 9:00 a.m. if your child is not going to be attending school for the day. If your child is not in school and we have not received a call, we will be calling you either at home or work to confirm your child's absence. If a call is not received, your child will be counted as an unexcused absence.
- * When your child needs to leave early from school for any reason, please come to the office and fill out a "Student Check-Out" form. Your student will not be released from their classroom until this form is completed. The intent is for our children's safety and no exceptions will be allowed.
- * The Williston Public School District has implemented a policy for hot lunch accounts that are not kept current. Students will receive notice when they have less than \$3.00 left in their lunch account. They will receive a notice every day. When their account is -\$3.00, you will receive a letter reminding you to send money. The District has the right to withhold hot lunch after a certain number of days and require a student to bring cold lunch until their account is paid. To save this inconvenience, please try to stay current on your child's hot lunch account.
