For Your Information

Community Action Partnership has received funding to provide financial assistance for transportation services for those who are accessing school, job training programs, or getting to and from their place of employment. Funding is specific to these uses only and cannot be used for medical transport.

Types of services which will be provided on a onetime basis is:

- * 1 \$50 gas card
- * 25 cab tickets
- * 1 monthly transit ticket

Eligible applicants must complete an intake form and provide proof of income.

Funding is limited and is provided on a first come, first serve basis. The program will end when funds are spent or by 9/30/11, whichever is first.
