REGISTRATION FORM FOR DRIVER'S EDUCATION MAY 31-JUNE 7TH, 2011

Driver's Education will begin May 31, 2001. We will accept 14 year olds if they have completed the 8th grade.

Both the classroom sessions and the driving sessions will begin at that time. You will schedule the driving sessions with the instructor.

CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION

The state requirement is for 30 hours of classroom instruction. If you miss a day, this must be made up (5 hours). Missing any time at all is discouraged.

The focus of this part of the driver's education is on traffic rules, regulations, handling emergencies, the DUI law, automobile insurance, etc.

Classroom instruction will follow the time schedule listed below:

May 31, June 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, 2011-from 7:30 am-12:30 pm

BEHIND THE WHEEL INSTRUCTION

Each student must satisfactorily complete 6 hours of driving with the instructor, plus 6 hours of observing. No permit is required to drive with a certified driver's education instructor. However, the student should have a driver's permit by the third week of class so that he/she can drive with other adults to gain more driving experience.

If a student fails either part of this class he/she will not receive the certificate that allows them to get a license before he/she is 16 years of age. The certificate may allow a student to receive a discount on their automobile insurance.

The cost of the class is \$125.00 and MUST accompany this registration form or you will not be registered for the class. Checks will not be deposited until the class begins.
