JAG 1 (Jobs for America's Graduates)-Students may take this class based on an application, interview and approval of instructor. Students work towards developing a healthy self-concept for home, school, and work; identifying a self-value system and how it affects life; demonstrating effective study skills, an openness to change, an ability to adapt to people and situations, and a willingness to accept responsibility for one's own actions. The JAG model requires a career association which the student belongs to and participates in with some out of school time required.

JAG II

Class Type: Elective
Grade Level: 10-11
Credit: 1

Pre-requisite: Must complete JAG I

Extra Costs: None

JAG II (Jobs for America's Graduates)-Student's, through the use of speakers, field trips, video and classroom instruction, will explore careers and prepare the skills necessary to attain those careers. Topics covered in addition to career exploration are: constructing a resume, constructing a job search, developing a letter of application, completing application forms, completing a job interview, following directions, practicing effective human relations, resigning from a job and demonstrating commitment to an organization.

JAG III

Class Type: Elective
Grade Level: 11-12
Credit: ½

Pre-requisite: Must complete JAG I and JAG II

JAG 3 (Jobs for America's Graduates)-Students will job shadow careers of their choice. There is limited in-class time, but required out of class time to complete the job shadows. Students will contact employers, arrange job shadows and turn in required reports on the jobs in order to receive credit.
