Class Type: Elective Grade Level: 10-12

Credit: 1/2

Pre-requisite: None

*This class will discuss the fundamentals of music and composition. This is a collegelevel class designed for students interested in pursuing music after high school.

♦ Music Technology

Class Type: Elective Grade Level: 9-12

Credit 1/2

Pre-requisite: Application, Teacher Recommendation

*This class will focus on the technology used in music and theatre. It is for students interested in lighting and sound technology. We will also study recording, set design and construction, and other theatre-related activities. You will be required to serve a minimum of 10 hours of service after school in the WHS Auditorium as a part of your final grade.

♦ Vocal Technique I (1st semester) Vocal Technique II (2nd semester)

Class Type: Elective Grade Level: 9-12

Credit: 1/2

Pre-requisite: Must be in choir

*This course is designed to prepare students for festival auditions. Other emphasis will be placed on small ensemble performances. Students will be taught music theory, sight-reading, and ear-training. Highly-motivated students who want to better their voices should take this class. They are also encouraged to create a small ensemble of students with whom to take this class. This could include duets, trios, quartets, etc.

♦ Applied Instrumental Technique I (1st semester) Applied Instrumental Technique II (2nd semester)

Class Type: Elective Grade Level: 9-12

Credit: 1/2

Pre-requisite: Must be in band

*This course is designed to prepare students for festival auditions. Other emphasis will be placed on small ensemble performances. Highly-motivated students who want to better their playing should take this class. They are also encouraged to create a small ensemble of students with whom to take this class. This could include duets, trios, quartets, etc.
