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Summer School

Williston High School sponsors an extensive summer school program, usually beginning the day after Memorial Day. Two or four-week remedial classes in English (120 hours) are offered along with 3-week enrichment for credit courses in social studies, business classes and physical education. A complete list of classes offered will be given to students during registration for the coming year.

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Driver's Education

- ◆ The class is available to students who have completed their freshman year in high school and also to 8th graders who will be 14 at the time of the class. The cost for the class is re-evaluated each year.
- ◆ Applications will be available to students during registration. All applications will be received on a first come, first served basis.

Driver's Education begins the same day as summer school and is divided into two parts

- ◆ Part one is the classroom instruction, which will meet for a total of 30 hours. The focus of the class is on traffic rules and regulations, handling emergencies, the DUI law, automobile insurance, etc.
- ◆ Part two is the behind the wheel instruction. Each student must satisfactorily complete six hours of driving with the instructor and six hours of observation. Driving times are arranged with the instructor.

If a student fails either part of this class, they will not receive a Driver's Ed. Certificate.
