1999-2000 NORTH DAKOTA HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION AND WILLISTON HIGH SCHOOL ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ACTIVITY PARTICIPATION

Any student, who represents Williston High School in an extra-curricular activity or interscholastic contest, must maintain a passing grade (a passing grade is considered to be a letter grade of D or higher) in at least four high school subjects with a credit value of one-half unit per semester. **Grades must always be computed from the beginning of the semester.**

Academic eligibility will be checked at the end of each six-week grading period. Students who are not passing four classes after a six-week grading period will be considered ineligible to participate. Students who are determined ineligible will have their academic eligibility checked on a weekly basis, and will become eligible to participate after having passing grades in four classes.

A student shall be doing passing work in a least four classes at the end of each semester to be considered eligible to participate. Students who are not passing four classes will be ineligible for a minimum of four weeks. To become eligible after the four week academic suspension, a student must have passing grades, computed from the opening of the semester, in four classes. Students who are determined ineligible after the four week suspension will have their academic eligibility checked on a weekly basis, and will become eligible to participate after having passing grades in four classes.

Students who are academically ineligible will not be allowed to "dress" and be part of the bench, nor will they be allowed to travel to away events during their time of ineligibility.

A seventh or eighth grade student must be passing in all his/her classes in order to be eligible to participate in extra curricular activities at the high school level. Academic eligibility will be checked at the end of every six-week grading period. Students who are not passing all classes after a six-week grading period will be considered ineligible to participate. Students who are determined ineligible will have their academic eligibility checked on a weekly basis, and will become eligible to participate when passing all their classes.

A seventh or eighth grade student participating at the junior high level must have their academic eligibility checked at the end of every six week grading period. Students who are not passing 75% of their classes after a six week grading period will be considered ineligible to participate. Students who are determined ineligible will have their academic eligibility checked on a weekly basis, and will become eligible to participate after having passing grades in 75% of their classes.
